It's coming down

Charter Environmental begins the second phase of demolition of Bldg. 408 at Fort Hamilton, N.Y., April 2. Phase one involved removing asbestos from the building. Huntsville Center's Facilities Reduction Program is working with the installation, New York District and contractor partners to remove, by traditional demolition, three multi-use buildings that were used for barracks, administrative and dining facility. The plan is to recycle or reuse as much of the material as possible and use the concrete and cinder block rubble to raise the elevation 4-6 inches in the area. This project is expected to be completed in May 2007.
